

## **Spooky Slime**

fith this spooky slime activity, children will get practice flowing directions and getting messy as they learn all pout slime! First, roll up your sleeves and start mixing the gredients together with a wooden spoon. Then, start neading it with your hands until you have a ce gooey, sticky substance. Finally, it's time add the spooky eyes, glitter, etc. to complete the slime asterpiece. Geared towards kindergarten through third rade students, this is a fun science activity for the classroom home!

### /hat You Need:

- 1 bottle of white washable school glue
- ¼ cup\_liquid starch, <u>slime activator</u> or <u>borax slime</u> <u>activator</u>
- 2-4 drops of food coloring
- Medium-sized mixing container such as a bowl or cauldron (this makes it super spooky!)
- · Wooden mixing spoon
- Optional: googly eyes, glitter, Halloween objects (e.g., ghosts, pumpkins, etc.)

### /hat You Do:


- 1. Explain to your child that today you will be making spooky slime!
- 2. Pour the glue into your container.
- 3. Instruct your child to add 2-4 drops of food coloring to the glue, then mix.
- 4. Show your child how to add in the liquid starch/slime activator one tablespoon at a time, mixing together as you add.
- 5. Mix all ingredients together until they resemble a gooey, sticky substance.
- 6. Invite your child to continue mixing it with their hands until it becomes slime. Ask questions such as "What do you notice happening? How does this feel? What does this remind you of?"
- 7. Have your child mix glitter, googly eyes, etc. to personalize their slime!
- 8. Play with the slime!
- 9. Store in a tightly closed container with a lid to reuse again and again!

ead a Halloween book such as <u>Room on the Broom by Julia Donaldson</u>, <u>Monster Mess! by Margery Cuyler</u>, or <u>Inside a House That Is</u> <u>aunted by Alyssa Satin Capucilli</u> and then have your child act out parts of the story using their slime!



### Ingredients

Ingredient Checklist

- 4 large eggs
- 1 ½ cups white sugar
- 1 cup vegetable oil
- 1 (15 ounce) can pumpkin puree
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 (3 ounce) package cream cheese, softened
- ½ cup butter, softened
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 cups sifted confectioners' sugar

### Directions

Instructions Checklist

### Step 1

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).

Step 2

In a medium bowl, mix the eggs, sugar, oil, and pumpkin with an electric mixer until light and fluffy. Sift together the flour, baking powder, baking soda, cinnamon and salt. Stir into the pumpkin mixture until thoroughly combined.

### Step 3

Spread the batter evenly into an ungreased 10x15 inch jellyroll pan. Bake for 25 to 30 minutes in preheated oven. Cool before frosting.

### Step 4

To make the frosting, cream together the cream cheese and butter. Stir in vanilla. Add confectioners' sugar a little at a time, beating until mixture is smooth. Spread evenly on top of the cooled bars. Cut into squares.


